**Eligibility:** All riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration Card or SACU Licence. Other riders must produce a licence and Start Permission confirming Insurance from their FMN.

**Entries:** 70 riders maximum, online entry only, entry fee of £16 per adult, £6 per youth. Entries will close on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2020 at which point should the maximum number of entries be exceeded the following selection criteria will be used to determine the final entry list (riders who do not get a ride will receive a full refund and have first refusal on an entry at the next event):

1. Priority given to riders who live within in the South Western Centre and Cornwall
2. Priority given to riders who have ridden at least 1 WEMC events in 2019
3. Priority given to riders who have ridden at least 3 WEMC events in 2019
4. Should the above be exhausted a ballot will take place

**NO DAY ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED, ENTRANCE TO THE VENUE WILL BE FOR PRE-ENTERED RIDERS AND OFFICIALS ONLY, NO SPECTATORS.**

**Start:** Paradise, Halshanger, Ashburton, TQ13 7HY, 11am, riders not to arrive before 9am.

**Classes:** White route – novice level, yellow route – sportsman level, red route – clubman/clubman expert level (adult and youth riders will be classified separately in the results).

**Method of marking:** To be run under TRS 22B Non-stop ruling.

**Sections:** 3 laps of 12 sections, various starts.

**Final Instructions & Results:** To be emailed to riders and posted on the club website, [www.westofenglandmc.co.uk](http://www.westofenglandmc.co.uk) and Facebook page.

**A caterer will be in attendance throughout the day.**

**\*\*Covid-19 restrictions/precautions\*\*:**

- Riders encouraged to follow the latest Government guidelines with regards to travelling to the venue.
- No spectators are permitted.
- No observers are required to attend on the day unless they have pre-booked with the Secretary of the Meeting or Clerk of the Course.
- On arrival, you will be directed to where to park your vehicle and given instructions as to the signing on procedure and format for day.
